Crocheted Bucket Hat

Cotton Yarn - worsted weight cotton yarn, 4oz

Size F Crochet Hook Chain 4.

Row 1: 11 dc in 4thch from hook (first 3 chs count as a dc); join 3^{rd} ch of original 4 chains with slip stitch. total chs:12 dc.



Row 2:

Ch 3 (counts as a dc on all rows), dc in same ch as joining; 2 dc in each dc; join with slip stitch: total chs 24dc.

Row 3:

Ch 3, dc in same ch as joining; dc in next dc; *2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc; rep from * around; join with slip stitch: total chs 36 dc.

Row 4:

Ch 3, dc in same ch as joining; dc in next 2 dc; *2 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * around; join with slip stitch: total chs 48 dc.

Row 5:

Ch 3, dc in same ch as joining; dc in next 3 dc; *2 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc; rep from * around; join with slip stitch, total chs 60 dc.

Row 6: Ch 3, dc in same ch as joining; dc in next 4 dc; *2 dc in next dc, dc in next 4 dc; rep from * around; join with slip stitch, total chs 72 dc.

Row 7: Ch 3, working only in the back loops dc in each dc; join with slip stitch

Row 8: Ch 3, dc in each dc; join with slip stitch

Rows 9 through 16: Rep Row 8.

Row 17 - 19: Ch 3, hdc in same ch as joining; hdc in next 3 dc; *2 hdc in next dc, hdc in next 3 dc; rep from * around; join in 3rd chain of beginning chain 3.

Finish off and weave in loose ends.

To make stripped version, switch colors for rows 13 through 16.
