## Red Sox Cap

Size 6 (US) / 4.0mm needles, 13" long
1 skein worsted weight Lily Sugar and Cream all cotton yarn (3 oz) - Red (can be done pink or other colors too)

1 skein worsted weight Lily Sugar and Cream all cotton yarn - White

Yarn needle for sewing seam

Cast on 102 stitches with red yarn.
Rows 1, 3, 5, 7: Knit across.
Rows 2, 4, 6, 8: Purl across.
Row 9: Knit 47 tie white yarn to red in a knot in the back, knit 7 white, knit 48 red
Row 10: Purl 49 red, purl 7 white, purl 46 red
Row 11: Knit 46 red, knit 3 white, knit 2 red, knit 2 white, knit 49 red
Row 12: Purl 49 red, purl 2 white, purl 3 red, purl 2 white, purl 46 red
Row 13: Knit 46 red, knit 3 white, knit 2 red, kit 2 white, knit 49 red
Row 14: Purl 49 red, purl 6 white, purl 47 red
Row 15: Knit 47 red, purl 6 white, knit 49 red
Row 16: Purl 49 red, purl 2 white, purl 2 red, purl 3 white, purl 46 red
Row 17: Knit 46 red, knit 2 white, knit 3 red, knit 2 white, knit 49 red
Row 18: Purl 49 red, purl 2 white, purl 2 red, purl 3 white, purl 46 red
Row 19: Knit 46 red, Knit 7 white, knit 49 red
Row 20: Purl 48 red, purl 7 white, purl 47 red
Row 21 - 28: Knit a row, Purl a row (or until hat is $\sim 4$ ")
Row 29: Knit 10 stitches, Knit 2 stitches together, repeat across the row. (this will decrease the stitch count by 8 to 94 stitches).
Row 30: Purl across
Row 31 :Knit 9 stitches, knit 2 stitches together, -repeat across row ( 86 sts ).
Row 32: Purl row.
Row 33: Knit 8, Knit 2 together across (78 sts).
Row 34: Purl row.
Row 35: Knit 7, Knit 2 together across row (70 sts).
Row 36: Purl row.

Row 37: Knit 6, knit 2 together across row (62 sts).
Row 38: Purl row.
Row 39: Knit 5, Knit 2 together across row (54 sts).
Row 40: Purl row.
Row 41: Knit 4, Knit 2 together across row (48 sts).
Row 42: Purl row.
Row 43: Knit 3, Knit 2 together across row (40 sts).
Row 44: Purl row.
Row 45: Knit 2, knit 2 together across row (32 sts).
Row 46: Purl row.
Row 47: Knit 2 together across row (16 sts).
Row 48: Purl row.
Row 49: Knit 2 together across row (8 sts).
When 8 or fewer stitches remain - cut yarn $\sim 12$ inches from hat. With a yarn needle thread remaining stitches through the needle. Turn hat inside out and overhand stitch side seam together. Weave in any loose ends.
