

## Stripes & Ripples Knitted Hat

2oz Sugar and Cream yarn, 2 oz in coordinating color

Size 6 needles

Cast on 108 Stitches

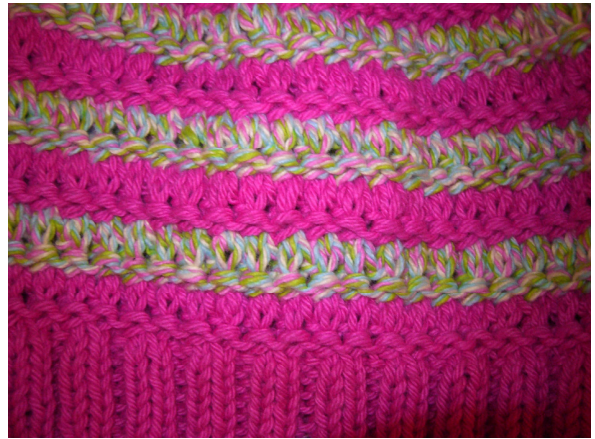
Knit 2 Purl 2 for 8 rows

Row 9: Knit

Row 10: Purl 1, \* Knit 2 together; repeat across row, purl last stitch

Row 11: Knit 1, \* knit into the front and the back of the next stitch; repeat double knitting into each stitch across, knit 1 normally at the end of the row

Row 12: Purl



Change to 2nd color. You do not have to cut yarn here. I just tend to catch the color I am not working with around my working color before each Row 3 or Row 7 to keep from getting "long" loops.

Row 13: Knit

Row 14: Purl 1, \* Knit 2 together; repeat across, purl last stitch

Row 15: Knit 1, \* knit into the front and the back of the next stitch; repeat double knitting into each stitch across, knit 1

Row 16: Purl

Change back to original color

Repeat rows 1-8 three more time (8 stripes)

Row 33: Knit

Row 34: Purl 1, \* Knit 2 together; repeat across row, purl last stitch

Row 35: Knit across ( this becomes a decrease row since you are not replacing the stitches )

Row 36: Purl

Change to 2nd color

Row 37: Knit

Row 38: Purl 1, \* Knit 2 together; repeat across, purl last stitch

Row 39: Knit 1, \* knit into the front and the back of the next stitch; repeat double knitting into each stitch across, knit 1

Row 40: Purl

Change back to original color.

Row 41: Knit

Row 42: Purl 1, \* Knit 2 together; repeat across row, purl last stitch

Row 43: Knit across ( this becomes a decrease row since you are not replacing the stitches )

Row 44: Purl

Change to 2nd color

Row 37: Knit

Row 38: Purl 1, \* Knit 2 together; repeat across, purl last stitch

Row 39: Knit across

Row 40: Purl

Change back to original color. Knit 2 together across. Cut yarn leaving 12 inches. Using yarn needle thread remaining stitches through yarn. Turn hat inside out and overhand edges together.
